

BPS – SAFETY TRAINING

- Epidemiology and transmission of Hepatitis B and C, HIV and other diseases as applicable
- Explanation of the exposure control plan
- Specific safety policies for job tasks
- Use of personal protective equipment
- Information on Hepatitis B vaccine
- How to report an exposure
- How an exposure is followed up
 - Where to find a copy of the regulation

When and Who to Train

Offer initial training (prior to job task)

Annual re-training or review

- Re-train if a problem needs to be addressed
- If a new procedure or task with risk is introduced

Include full time, part time & temporary employees who provide direct patient care (job classification 1 & 2)

Safety Trainer Requirements

Trainer must be knowledgeable on subject

Trainer must be able to relate regulations to specific job tasks

Trainer competency must be documented

- Specialized courses, degree programs, work experience
